Jeromin Zettelmeyer is Director of Bruegel, the Brussels-based economic think tank (since September 2022). Prior to that, he was deputy director of the Strategy, Policy and Review Department at the International Monetary Fund, where he oversaw work on sovereign debt and external policies. From 2016-2019, he was the Senior Fellow at the Peterson Institute for International Economics, after previously serving as Director-General for Economic Policy at the German Ministry for Economic Affairs (2014-2016), Director of Research and Deputy Chief Economist at the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (2008–2014) and as staff member of the International Monetary Fund (1994–2008). He is a CEPR research fellow and a member of CESifo and was the founding chair of the CEPR Research and Policy Network on European Economic Architecture (2018-2019).
