



Dr. Cornelia Holthausen is Director General Macprudential Policy and Financial Stability (DGMF) at the European Central Bank since 2021. DGMF provides analyses and policy advice on macroprudential policies, financial stability, financial regulation and supervision. It identifies and monitors systemic risks stemming from the banking and the broader financial sectors in the euro area, including those emanating from market developments, insurance companies, pension and investment funds. DGMF is responsible, together with the ECB Banking Supervision, for carrying out stress-testing exercises to assess the banking system's resilience as well as macroprudential stress tests covering the broader financial sector. Additionally, DGMF is responsible for preparing the ECB macroprudential policy decisions.

Previously, she held positions as Deputy Director General in DG Markets and DG Economics, as well as Head of the Financial Research Division at the ECB.
